2. *Missions Emphasis*—attitude of mission, world missions, Haiti food, trips, sending and doing
3. *Children's Ministry*—innovative, nursery, tailored and unique, Kindermusic, Rainbow Club
3. *Innovative*—try new things, entrepreneurial, incubator, open-minded, progressive, willingness, risk/reward mindset, new ministries
3. *Staff*—both pastors, preaching, competent leadership, multigenerational leadership, team ministry that works well together, amazing staff
6. *Deacons/Giving*—deacon's ministry, outreach, giving, hands on, helpful, surplus handling
6. *Youth Program*—comprehensive programs, vibrant, service projects, community oriented
8. *Worship*—creativity, flexible worship times, integrated/story-formed worship, talented leaders
9. *College Students*—welcomed, drawn to services, opportunity to serve
9. *Small Groups*—large number of people involved in a large number of small groups
10. *Additional Comments*—Piecemakers, Summer Programs, Openness, Adult Programming

What service/ministry does the OC area not have that you think it should have?

1. *After School Program*—place for kids, supervision of kids, latch key
2. *Community Services*—community garden, laundry, financial assistance for daycare of adoption or housing, family day activities, Mom's day out, serving the poor
3. *Assistance for Elderly*—respite care, day care, caregivers, help
3. *Singles Ministry*—helping, networking, single moms
5. *Mentoring*—Biblical parenting, new Christians, support ministry
5. *Other Hispanic*—bilingual daycare/preschool, Hispanic service, radio translation, interaction
5. *Transportation*—public taxi, to/from church, for those that cannot drive

If we are going to reach people who are not being reached, what are we going to have to do differently?

1. *Go to them*—ministries for special groups—AA, divorced, special needs, YATEC, etc., call and ask, interesting activities to involve them, special interest groups
2. *Be welcoming*—less intimidating, invite to dinner, create friendship groups, more inclusive
3. *Changed Attitudes*—get out of comfort zone, accept being uncomfortable, accept differences, share the love, would Tim Brown's mom come?
4. *Know needs/people*—know needs of community, better sense of who or what is in community, educate about group(s) trying to reach
5. *Invite people*—intentional contact with unchurched, follow up with friendship, more events to extend invitation
6. *Build relationships*—throw a party, block party, socialize with those unlike us
6. *Technological upgrades*—TV/internet/radio ministry, thought for the day on internet/phone
8. *Provide information*—information center, how to outreach class, information on programs available with explanations and/or directions, marketing
9. *Mentoring/Counseling*—lay counselors, skills teaching, younger generation involvement
9. *Outdoor Services*—more services in the park
9. *Relaxed Rules*—coffee in sanctuary, no dress code, share church roles with each other
10. *Additional Comments*—facility changes, less religious language, cultural programming, do church differently

Who are the invisible people in our church?

1. *Singles*—including older singles
2. *Uninvolved*—without passion, waiting to be asked, don't know how to get involved, not in Bible study, bench-sitters, those without ownership
3. *Widows*—
4. *Twenty-something's*—young married, post high, post college
5. *Elderly*—
6. *Hispanics*—diverse population members, the unorganized-other cultures
7. *College students*—
8. *Single parents*—single moms and single parents
9. *Disconnected*—those with no connections, group of friends
10. *Hurting*—struggle inside, don't want to share problems, those with pain
11. *Poor*—*low income families, lower economic status*
12. *Sunday Only*—those that only come for Sunday worship
13. *Additional Comments*—Balcony people, divorced, marginal kids, middle age-no kids, non "locals", outcasts

What makes me weep or pound the table?

1. *Mourning what we miss*—miss the organ, hymnbooks, choir, stand too long, too much structure
2. *Elements of worship*—prayers/praying, praising God, music, drama, communion
3. *Hurting/Lonely*—people not accepted at church, lonely people/kids, people with problems they cannot talk about
4. *Negative attitudes*—complainers, arrogant attitudes, close minded
5. *Social issues*—injustices in Hispanic community, economic concerns, hunger awareness
6. *Discipleship*—illiteracy of Bible, lack of inviting/telling others about Jesus, pray aloud
7. *Faith stories*—faith stories, parade of joy, testimonies
8. *Outreach*—caring ministry, Bridge, Atlas, food bags
9. *Parenting*—teaching kids about Christ, dysfunctional families
10. *Additional Comments*—attitudes, disconnected, facility limitations, preaching, ministry programming, too busy, technology problems, Trinity process

What If?

1. *Facility ideas*—open 24/7, had a Laundromat, use existing building too, let identity and function define us and new building, retreat center, soccer fields, coffee shop, car service center, recreation facility, kneeling chairs/pews, room to dance
2. *Welcoming*—everyone wears nametags, advertise more, everyone feels welcome, welcome pack for visitors, welcoming service to get people plugged into OC
3. *Finances*—everyone tithed, we didn't hold back, stimulus package given to church, large donation
4. *After school program*—for kids and teens, tutoring service, additional staff and space for after school program
4. *Missions*—develop partnerships with Uganda church, more proactive in food crisis, set more people to missions
4. *Overflow ideas*—additional worship services-Sun AM or Sat PM, worship in different locations, spaces for simultaneous services
4. *Service changes*—communion every Sunday, college worship services, hymn sing, rock and roll worship, screen shows music and words
4. *Social gatherings*—meals—every Sunday/Wed nights/more potlucks, random supper meetings, golf/recreation ministry
4. *Support*—Counseling service offered, crisis center, more support groups, 24/7 hotline
